History of the Omega Phi Alpha Scholarship Trust

The Omega Phi Alpha Scholarship Trust was founded in 1996 by the first Board of Trustees: Janice Titsworth, Pamela McEwen, and Sarah VanDyke. An Omega Phi Alpha scholarship was the dream of Ginger McGarity, who appointed the first Board of Trustees to carry out her desire for OPA to help financially in promoting and furthering the education of active sisters around the country. The first scholarship was awarded in 1997 and yearly since. The number of scholarships and their award amount are based on the interest earned from donations made to the Scholarship Trust annually. This award may be used for tuition, fees, books or living expenses. The Scholarship Trust continues to be lead by a Board of Trustees comprised of one active sister, one alumnae sister and the VP- Finance for Omega Phi Alpha. Its status as a 501c(3) non-profit makes it a tax deductible organization for all donors and sponsors.

When: July 17, 2004

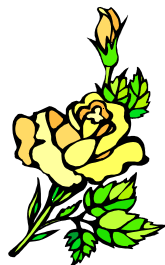
Where: Nashville's Historic Centennial Park

Collecting Donations and Pledges

We are asking all active chapters to raise \$250 dollars for the chapter as a whole. This is a minimum amount - you may raise as much as you can. That equates to approximately \$125 per delegate if you are sending two to convention. When you arrive for registration Saturday morning, you may bring donations or pledge sheets.

We are asking all individual alumnae, including NEB, who are walking to raise \$150 each. Any larger amounts will be greatly appreciated.

All donations are tax deductible and receipts for donors can be found at www.Omega-phialpha.org. Please arrive at the walk registration with a minimum of \$100 dollars in donations or pledges. All pledges will be due by September 1, 2004.

Donations should be made to Omega Phi Alpha Scholarship Trust.

Alumnae or sisters not attending or walking are encouraged to donate toward your favorite chapter or sister's efforts, but a general donation will also be accepted and appreciated.

What can this walk do for our trust?

If 16 chapters raise \$250 in donations:

$$250 \times 16 = 4000$$

If 20 alumni raise \$150 in donations:

$$20 \times 150 = 3000$$
