

# Convention Service Project Poster Session

## Purpose:

In order to highlight the wide array of service projects that are developed and executed by the seventeen chapters across the country the National Executive Board has decided to hold a new workshop format for national convention on the Friday of our 2004 Convention in Nashville.

## Chapter responsibilities:

Decide as a chapter which service project from the last year has been a success for you as a group. Take this project and develop a presentation board or table for the event. This presentation can be in display, slide show (you will need to provide your own laptop), service materials, or table materials. If you wish to bring the materials for the display board, the national VP-Leadership will have the presentation boards in Nashville to construct the display. You will need to explain in detail your project, planning, and materials needed for the project. Have this information in a handout and be sure to have enough copies for all other chapters.

At the time of your poster session you will need to man the table with your project so that other sisters can browse along and learn more about your project. You will need to have the sister that is at the table be very knowledgeable about the project and its plan in your chapter. They will be answering questions from other chapters, alumni and nationals. The handouts will serve as resources for each chapter to take home and discuss the projects viability at their campus.

## Structure:

Each session will consist of 3 districts, 1 alumni project and three regional, national or international service opportunity displays.

The form attached to this letter is to register your project for poster sessions. Feel Free to register more than one. We will need to vary the projects.
